- Be a resident of Custer County.
- Attend (or plan to attend) Southwestern Oklahoma State University as a full-time student.
- Declare (or plan to declare) a major or minor in music, writing, art, or theatre.
- Incoming freshman through graduate-level students will be considered.

The following factors will be considered in the decision-making process, and any of them may be addressed in the application essay:

- Financial need.
- GPA and achievement in the arts.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate who best meets these criteria, but preference will be given to Weatherford High School graduates.
- Incomplete applications may not be considered.
